Strategic Plan 2021-26

Introduction:

This strategic plan has been developed by the <u>Board of Directors</u> of the Hammonds Plains Historical Society to provide goals and aims for the society, with the targeted time frame of 5 years (2021-26). It was created based on the progress from the previous 5 year plan (2014-19).

It should be noted that the plan was approved in November 2019, but due to the impact of COVID-19 little opportunity was afforded to work towards the goals of the plan during 2020 so the plan was revised to cover the 2021-26 time frame.

Background:

The **Hammonds Plains Historical Society** was established in 2010, after a yearlong series of planning meetings of original society members (Christina Parker, Cathy Munroe, Heather Kelly, Dave Haverstock, Joyce Evans), who saw the need to promote the history of the community.

We are a registered member of the Nova Scotia Joint Stocks and have a set of by-laws which outlines our governance. We have an eight member Board of Directors, which meets once a month. Membership to the society is open to any interested individual, with an annual \$10 membership fee.

Achievements:

Since its inception, the **Hammonds Plains Historical Society** has enjoyed an array of successful achievements, including:

- Hosting of 5 general meeting per year, which include a presentation of local history.
- Creation of display boards, used to promote Hammonds Plains history.
- Distribution of society newsletters at each of the general meetings.
- Initiation of an Oral History Project, in which seniors are interviewed (taped) about their memories of growing up in the community.
- The construction of a promotion roadside sign, in front of Uplands Park.
- Creation of web page (hammondsplainshistoricalsociety.ca) and Facebook site.
- Obtaining a storage area for society resources at the Hammonds Plains Community Center.
- Researching and compiling PowerPoint presentations on a variety of Hammonds Plains Historical topics.

Our Vision:

To gather, preserve and share the rich history of Hammonds Plains and surrounding area, with any and all interested people.

Our Goals:

- 1. To acquire, maintain, enhance and/or restore real and personal property of significant historical value in Nova Scotia.
- 2. To publish information, exhibit, display and promote the public awareness and enjoyment of real and personal property & significant historical value in Nova Scotia.
- 3. To work in conjunction with other groups, individuals and organizations who share goals in common with this society.
- 4. To seek governmental assistance of any nature including municipal, provincial and federal government agencies to further the objectives of the society and to coordinate in affiliation with and assist any such agency including the goal of the society.
- 5. To obtain funding from the public at large through direct gifts or various fund raising techniques to achieve the goal of the society.
